- i) New Pharmacy Technician starting 14.3.22. Recruiting for Practice Nurse.
- ii) SMP very busy with very high staff absences (mostly Covid). Large numbers of patients ringing surgery every day, with many using the call back function. Patient abuse towards staff increasing. Message regarding staff shortages to go on phone system. Seal Bay (formerly Bunn Leisure) to signpost holidaymakers to 111 instead of SMP.
- iii) Yearly medication reviews patients now to take their own height, weight and blood pressure in surgery and hand results to reception. Any medication changes would then be implemented.
- iv) Repeat prescriptions will not be done by Boots from 1.4.22. Patients must order their own medication and allow 10 days. To go in Newsletter, SMP screens and Facebook page.
- v) E-consult no longer available at weekends.
- vi) Care Shop running workshops to assist patient with digital access.
